Call Me Beauty 101 + AR Rucker Middle School

Call Me Beauty Mentoring Program is excited to continue our work with A.R. Rucker Middle School in Lancaster, SC, offering the Call Me Beauty 101: Girl's Circle course. This semester marks our third year partnering with the school, and we are so proud of the girls' continued commitment to the program. It's wonderful to see them choose to participate semester after semester! For the Fall 2024 semester, we focused on our "Friendship" course, which is based on an evidencebased curriculum. Katreka L. Durham, MS, LPCA, facilitated the sessions, meeting with the girls every Friday throughout the duration of the course, from 9/13/24 to 11/8/24. At the start and end of the course, participants completed testing to assess the course's impact on their understanding of friendship and its importance.

Little Beauties + Self Love || Fall Girl's Circle



This fall, Call Me Beauty Mentoring hosted "Little Beauties + Self Love," a program designed for our 4K through Elementary school aged girls. During this series, we read books with the girls and engaged in fun, related activities.

We also offered "Girls Circle: Expressing My Individuality" for our Middle and High school participants. This series focused on celebrating our unique qualities, embracing diversity, and nurturing personal growth.



Period Product Drive + Girl Flow Partnership

Call Me Beauty Mentoring partnered with Girl Flow of Charlotte, NC, from 7/29/24 to 8/9/24 to collect period product donations for those in need. Girl Flow is dedicated to breaking the stigma and shame surrounding menstruation, while also working to eliminate period poverty.

Thanks to the generosity of our community, we were able to collect 2,099 tampons, 617 pads, 414 liners, and 120 personal wipes. On 9/8/24, we hosted our "Period Product Drive Pack Party" at Municipal Justice Center Park, where we packed 450 Girl Flow bags with menstrual products. A special thank you to United Way of Lancaster County and Lancaster Promise Neighborhood for graciously allowing us to place drop-off boxes at their locations.
